

## Art Students Rocked Their Block

The Art Department hosted *Rock Your Block*, a Steamroller Woodblock Printing event on Tuesday, November 19 in the GWC Fine Arts Plaza. Students from the Printmaking class put on an impressive demonstration of this technique. After spending hours carving an intricate design on a wood block, it is inked, placed on the ground, and covered with a printable cloth and a thick pad.



A 3 ton steamroller rolls over it to press the image on to the cloth, which is then peeled off the wood to expose the print.



Dozens of prints hung on a clothesline that ran around the perimeter of the plaza, creating a festive look. The designs were impressive, especially since most of the students are in their first semester of the program.

Guests were invited to participate by carving smaller woodblocks to create their own print. The six hour event included live music and a food truck, attracting a large number of students and campus personnel.



### Women's Water Polo Swam Away for a Back to Back SoCal Championship!



**WOMEN'S WATER POLO - 2013 SoCal Champions (27-0)** swam away with the No. 1 spot for a back to back SoCal Championship. The 10-8 defeat of Riverside City College secured Golden West the No. 1 seed into the State Championships.

**MEN'S WATER POLO (23-3)** finished 2nd in SoCal, and are now focused on bringing home a three-peat State Championship.

**RUSTLER FOOTBALL (9-1)** defeated Saddleback 30-6 finishing the most successful regular season in Golden West history. The team finished second in the Southern California Conference, No. 3 in the National Division and will move on to the Southern California Bowl, on November 22nd. The semi-final playoff game will be played against Riverside City College, at Riverside, kick off is scheduled for 6:00pm.

**MEN'S SOCCER (10-8-3, 7-4-3)** tied with the Dons, 0-0 last week to finish their season in an exciting, yet scoreless final match. It was a game to highlight both teams' defense, never allowing either offense to make a real play for the back of the net. The men are now finished with their regular season.

**WOMEN'S SOCCER (7-7-7, 6-5-5)** ended their season in a heartbreaking tie at Saddleback. Alexis Ramierez was the only Rustlers to find the back of the net in the 90th minute of the game.

**WOMEN'S VOLLEYBALL (14-3, 8-3)** swept Riverside in their final home match of the season. Keeping Riverside from ever gaining momentum, the dynamic duo of Jordyn Sanchez and Tyler Davis put up a combined 23 kills and 27 digs for the match. The women travel to Irvine tomorrow seeking redemption in their conference final match of the season.
