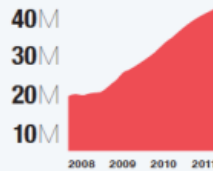

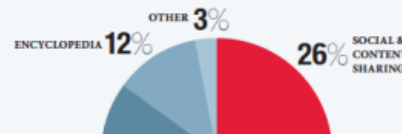
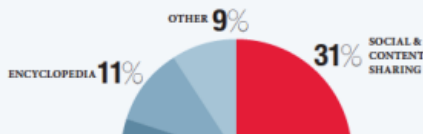
WHERE STUDENTS GO FOR UNORIGINAL WORK.
